A) Community Development Committee Re: Proposed Bylaw Text Amendments - 2009 July

The Community Development Committee submitted a report proposing a number of text amendments to the Burnaby Zoning Bylaw and Burnaby Sign Bylaw. The Committee noted these text amendments clarify certain aspects of the bylaw, and make minor amendments in support of existing practices and Council policies.
