STILL CREEK CONNECTOR: PRELOAD

PURPOSE: To obtain approval to award a contract for the Still Creek Connector Preload.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. **THAT** a contract be awarded to the lowest bidder, Mainland Civil Works Inc., for the Still Creek Connector Preload, for a total cost of \$767,655.00 with final payment based on actual quantities and unit prices tendered.


REPORT

Sixteen tenders for this contract, ranging from \$767,655.00 to \$1,090,041.75, were received by the closing time of 3:00 p.m., Monday, 2009 December 07 and were opened in the presence of the firms bidding.

The work of this contract involves the placement of road structure and preload granular material; construction of temporary Lock-Block TM retaining walls and reconstruction of stone chip path.

The recommended bidder, Mainland Civil Works Inc., has not undertaken a contract for the City in the past; however reference checks by our consultant indicates that they have successfully completed a similar type of contract within the Lower Mainland in a satisfactory manner. Our consultant's review indicates the contractor has the equipment and personnel capability to successfully complete the work required under this contract. The Director Engineering concurs with this recommendation.

Appearing elsewhere on the Council agenda for reconsideration and final adoption is a Capital Works By-Law report seeking funding approval for this project. These expenditures are included in the Major Roads component of the 2010 Provisional Financial Plan.
