HASTINGS STREET INFRASTRUCTURE RENEWAL:
WILLINGDON TO DELTA**

PURPOSE: To obtain approval to award a contract for Hastings Street infrastructure renewal, Willingdon to Delta.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT a contract be awarded to the lowest tenderer, Sandpiper Contracting LLP for Hastings Street infrastructure renewal, Willingdon to Delta, for a total cost of \$2,555,393.12 including HST in the amount of \$273,792.12 with final payment based on actual quantities and unit prices tendered.

REPORT

Three tenders for this contract, ranging from \$2,555,393.12 to \$2,937,480.00 were received by the closing time of 3:00 p.m. Thursday 2010 July 15 and were opened by staff in the presence of representatives of the firms bidding.

The work of this contract involves the construction of: ± 700 m of 250 mm to 525 mm PVC Storm Sewer with service connections; ± 700 m of 200 mm to 250 mm PVC Sanitary Sewer with service connections; ± 1350 m of 200 mm to 300 mm ductile iron watermain with service connections; a hanging basket irrigation system; ± 16,300 m² pavement milling; and, ± 1860 tonnes of pavement overlay.

The lowest tenderer, Sandpiper Contracting LLP has completed several contracts for the City in the past and all were completed to the satisfaction of the City. The consultant, Delcan Corporation, indicates the contractor has the capability to successfully complete the work required under this contract.

The consultant has evaluated these tenders and is of the opinion that the lowest tenderer's price is competitive and reflective of current market conditions and recommends the above noted contract be awarded to the lowest tenderer. The Director Engineering concurs with this recommendation.
