**PURPOSE:** To obtain approval to award a contract for the rehabilitation of Canada Way at Boundary Road intersection.

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**RECOMMENDATION:**

1. **THAT** a contract be awarded to the lowest bidder, Imperial Paving Ltd., for the rehabilitation of Canada Way at Boundary Road intersection, for a total cost of \$1,443,527.68 including \$154,663.68 HST with final payment based on actual quantities and unit prices tendered.

**REPORT**

Five tenders for this contract, ranging from \$1,443,527.68 to \$1,893,263.68 were received by the closing time of 3:00 p.m., Monday, 2010 June 07 and were opened in the presence of the firms bidding.

The work of this contract involves the construction of curbs, roadworks, traffic signals, street lighting, paving and related work.

The recommended bidder, Imperial Paving Ltd., has satisfactorily completed several projects for the City. Our consultant's review indicates the contractor has the equipment and personnel capability to successfully complete the work required under this contract. The Director Engineering concurs with this recommendation.

Appearing elsewhere on the Council agenda, for reconsideration and final adoption, is a Capital Works By-law report seeking partial funding approval for this project. These expenditures are included in the Major Roads component of the 2010 Annual Financial Plan.
