2010 MAJOR ROADS NETWORK INFRASTRUCTURE
REHABILITATION PROGRAM**

PURPOSE: To obtain approval to award a contract for major roads network infrastructure rehabilitation program.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. **THAT** a contract be awarded to the lowest bidder, Lafarge Canada Inc. C.O.B. as Columbia Bitulithic, for the 2010 Major Roads Network Infrastructure Rehabilitation Program for a tendered total cost of \$1,341,337.61, including \$143,714.74 HST, with final payment based on actual quantities and unit prices tendered.

REPORT

Four tenders for this contract, ranging from \$1,341,337.61 to \$1,939,919.59 were received by the closing time of 3:00 p.m. Monday 2010 June 21 and were opened by staff in the presence of representatives of the firms bidding.

The work of this contract involves the performance of rehabilitation and related work on various roads of the major Road Network within the City of Burnaby.

The recommended bidder, Lafarge Canada Inc. C.O.B. as Columbia Bitulithic, has completed several contracts for the City in the past and all were completed to the satisfaction of the City. Our consultant's review indicates the contractor has the equipment and personnel capability to successfully complete the work required under this contract. The Director Engineering concurs with this recommendation.

Funding for this project was previously approved by Council. These expenditures are included in the Street and Lane Rehabilitation component of the 2010 Annual Financial Plan.
