WATERMAIN REPLACEMENT PROGRAM – PACKAGE ‘A’
PURPOSE: To obtain approval to award a contract for construction of replacement watermains and related work.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. **THAT** a contract be awarded to the lowest bidder, Hyland Excavating Ltd., for the replacement of watermains for a total cost of \$912,098.15 with final payment based on actual quantities and unit prices tendered.

REPORT

Six tenders for this contract, ranging from \$912,098.15 to \$1,170,163.05 were received by the closing time of 3:00 p.m., Monday, 2010 February 01 and were opened in the presence of the firms bidding.

The work of this contract involves the construction of approximately 2,000 m of watermain and other related work.

The recommended bidder, Hyland Excavating Ltd., has satisfactorily completed numerous projects for the City. The consultant's review indicates the contractor has the experience and resources to successfully complete the work of this contract. The Director Engineering concurs with the above recommendation.

Appearing elsewhere on the Council agenda is a report seeking funding approval for this project. These expenditures are included in the Water Utility component of the 2010 Provisional Financial Plan.
