**REPORT**

Burnaby City Council, at its Closed meeting held on 2011 April 04, received a report from the Finance and Civic Development Committee proposing the naming of the portable building on the Stoney Creek Community School grounds as the “Jennifer Atchison Environmental Centre” in recognition of the contribution Ms. Atchison made to the community, especially in the restoration of the watershed.

Ms. Jennifer Atchison (1938 – 2010) was a passionate Burnaby Streamkeeper, environmental advocate, and the heart of the Stoney Creek Environment Committee. Ms. Atchison was instrumental in that group’s achievement in environmental restoration in the watershed in conjunction with many partners, including the City of Burnaby.

Ms. Atchison received two awards – the City of Burnaby’s Environment Award for Community Stewardship in 2010, and a BC Achievement Award in 2008.
