SUBJECT: NEW CLUBHOUSE AT RIVERWAY GOLF COURSE

PURPOSE: To provide an update on the construction progress.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT this report be received for information.

REPORT

Since staff's 2010 November report to the Finance and Civic Development Committee, the Contractor has focused their efforts on completing the Clubhouse building by the end of January 2011. The interior work is virtually complete with the exception of some millwork items which are in progress. The exterior elements of the building are now complete and the Contractor is in the process of landscaping the site and attending to some minor components of the remaining asphalt paving.

The Contractor spent much of December and January installing kitchen equipment, which is expected to be in place and operational by the end of this month. The mechanical and electrical systems have been commissioned and are fully operational.

The Contractor has requested that the consultants perform final deficiency inspections on 2011 January 25 in order to obtain substantial performance of the contract. Once substantial performance is achieved and final approvals are obtained from the City's Inspectors, the building will be turned over to the City. In anticipation of taking possession of the building in early February, orders have been placed for furnishings to fit out the various spaces within the building.

The project is on budget and on schedule. A detailed report outlining the final project cost will be submitted at the completion of the contract with Bird Construction Ltd.
