SUBJECT: 2011 ELECTION BYLAWS

PURPOSE: To obtain Council authorization to prepare bylaws for conducting Advance and

Special Voting Opportunities for the 2011 Local Government Election and to

enter into an agreement with School District 41 regarding cost sharing.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT Council authorize the City Solicitor to prepare a bylaw to provide additional Advance Voting Opportunities on 2011 November 05, 08, 09, and 16.

- **2. THAT** Council authorize the City Solicitor to prepare a bylaw to provide a Special Voting Opportunity for qualified residents of care homes and seniors facilities on 2011 November 08 as outlined in Appendix 1 of the report, and for qualified residents hospitalized in Burnaby General Hospital on general voting day, 2011 November 19.
- **3. THAT** Council authorize the City Clerk to execute an agreement with School District No. 41 to share in the costs of the 2011 local government election for school trustees.

REPORT

The Local Government Act requires the adoption of election bylaws and agreements for the conduct of local government elections.

Advance Voting Opportunities

Prior to 2008, the Local Government Act required voters to sign an affidavit providing their reason for voting at an advance voting opportunity. In 2008, the Local Government Act was amended to allow any elector to vote at an advance voting opportunity rather than on general voting day. This resulted in a much larger turnout for advance voting than in previous elections; in 2008 2,641 electors voted (8% of total votes cast) in one of the four Advance Voting Opportunities as compared to 1,058 (4.8% of total votes cast) in the previous election in 2005. Staff expect the number of advance voters to be even greater in 2011 as a result of increased awareness that advance voting is open to all Burnaby voters as well as the general increase in population within Burnaby.

Re: 2011 ELECTION BYLAWS

In accordance with the Local Government Act, the City of Burnaby is required to hold at least two Advance Voting Opportunities, one of which must be 10 days prior to general voting day or Wednesday, 2011 November 09. Since 1983 and the last 10 elections, Council has provided voters with four days to cast their ballot in advance of general voting day. To select the advance dates for this election, staff referred to voter feedback and determined offering earlier advance voting on Saturday, November 05th could be beneficial in accommodating retired residents who leave for warmer climates during the winter months. The additional two dates were selected based on past practices and availability of Shadbolt Centre, a cost effective and convenient location.

The cost incurred in conducting the additional two days of voting includes pay for staff and is estimated to be about \$2,700 per day.

Therefore, in response to public feedback and in the interests of continuing to provide the highest level of customer service, staff is recommending four days of advance voting: 2011 November 05, 08, 09 and 16. With Council approval, voting will be held in Studio 103 - Shadbolt Centre for the Arts at 6450 Deer Lake Avenue, Burnaby, from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm on these dates.

Special Voting Opportunities

Traditionally, Council have also provided Special Voting Opportunities (SVO) for qualified individuals residing in care facilities or seniors' housing or who are hospitalized on voting day.

In 2008, the SVO for seniors' facilities and care homes was held on one of the weekdays of advance voting prior to general voting day. This was in consideration of requests from the facilities as more staff are available on weekdays to assist persons in attending the voting place within the facilities. This also avoids conflicts with other special events (Remembrance Day ceremonies) scheduled to take place at this time of year. As the feedback was very positive, it is recommended Council continue with this practice and suggest the date be established as 2011 November 08.

It is recommended that Council approve the 2011 local government election with special voting opportunities to be held at the date, times and locations as noted in Appendix 1. The voting for Burnaby General Hospital will still be held on general voting day, 2011 November 19.
