SUBJECT: BURNABY REMEMBERS PROJECT

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council approve expenditure for up to \$1,500 from the Commission budget for the Burnaby Remembers project.

REPORT

The Community Heritage Commission, at its meeting held on 2011 September 08, received information from staff seeking approval for expenditure to fund the annual 'Burnaby Remembers' project. This heritage project includes the costs of newspaper advertisements for the public to attend the City's Remembrance Day events, and to fund the publication of Burnaby's Honour Roll in the NewsLeader's special supplement "Courage Remembered", which is special tribute to the veterans from Burnaby and New Westminster. The Burnaby Honour Roll is a list of war dead from both World War I and World War II.

Arising from discussion, the Community Heritage Commission requested that Council authorize expenditure of up to \$1,500 for the Burnaby Remembers projects. The funds will be allocated from the Committees, Boards and Commissions budget.
