REPORT

CONSTRUCTION STATUS

A construction contract was awarded by Council on 2010 December 06 to Smith Bros. & Wilson (B.C.) Ltd. in the amount of \$28,627,402 (*exclusive of HST*). The contractor commenced work on site in early 2011 January in preparation for the demolition of the former Eastburn Community Centre.

During the month of September, the contractor's workforce has continued to make good progress on site. The under building parkade structure and majority of the adjacent mechanical spaces have been completed. In addition to the main structure, all underground services and backfill around the site are now complete.

The contractor's current focus involves the forming and placing of the suspended concrete slab over the parkade area which is approximately 60% in place, as well as completing the pool tanks and walls. With the placement of the suspended slab underway, several other sub-trades are becoming more involved on site as the building begins to take form.

During the month of November, the mechanical and electrical contractors will continue their rough-in throughout the parkade area and begin installation of some of the major mechanical equipment. Other efforts will concentrate on the main floor suspended slab conduit, pipe sleeves and radiant heating lines that need to be installed prior to the completion of the suspended slab.

The contractor's proposed completion date for this project is 2012 November. The site is well organized and the construction is proceeding on schedule.

Staff will continue to monitor the progress and will provide further updates on the progress of Edmonds Pool & Community Centre in future reports to the Finance and Civic Development Committee.
