SUBJECT: CONFEDERATION PARK RUBBERIZED TRACK
PURPOSE: To obtain approval to award a contract for the design, supply and installation of an illuminated rubberized track at Confederation Park.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. **THAT** a contract be awarded to Cedar Crest Lands (BC) Ltd. for the design, supply and installation of an illuminated rubberized track at Confederation Park for a total cost of \$691,444.32, including HST in the amount of \$74,083.32.

REPORT

One proposal for this contract was received by the closing time of 3:00 p.m., Thursday, 2011 April 28. The recommended proposal was evaluated as reflective of current market pricing and a technically compliant submission.

The work of this contract involves replacement of the current gravel walking and jogging track with an illuminated rubberized track surface at Confederation Park.

The recommended proponent, Cedar Crest Lands (BC) Ltd. has satisfactorily completed other sports related work for the City in the past. The Director Parks, Recreation & Cultural Services is satisfied that the proponent has the team (includes design subcontractor R.F. Binnie and Associates, electrical subcontractor DMD and Associates, and track surfacing subcontractor Ocean Marker Sport Surfaces Ltd.) that has the experience and resources to successfully complete the work of this contract on a timely basis.

Appearing elsewhere on the agenda for final reading is the funding request for this project which is included in the 2011 Annual Capital Budget.
