An application was received requesting in-kind assistance with the printing of material for the 2011 Empty Bowls Gala event to be held on 2011 April 20 at the Hilton Metrotown Hotel. The event raises funds to address food security issues for Burnaby children. In 2009, the Empty Bowls Project raised over \$22,000 which was used to fund food security community projects such as "Kids in the Kitchen" and "Eat Smart" programs where children learn how to cook nutritious food. School and community based breakfast programs and many after school and homework club snack programs were also supported through this project.
