SUBJECT: 2011 BC PROVINCIAL RINGETTE A, B & C CHAMPIONSHIPS

PURPOSE: GRANT REQUEST

RECOMMENDATION:

1. **THAT** Council approve a grant up to the value of \$3,000 to the Burnaby New Westminster Ringette Association for in-kind services to print a multi-page tournament program.

REPORT

The Burnaby New Westminster Ringette Association has requested a contribution of in-kind services to print a multi-page program for their Provincial Ringette Championships which will be held 2011 March 10 - March 13. The printing would be done by the City's print shop.

The tournament has a maximum of 45 teams attending from around British Columbia. It is expected there will be 800 athletes and coaches and 500 family members, friends, and officials for a total of 1,300 event participants. Funds raised from hosting the event will be used to offset event costs and establish legacies that include subsidized registration fees for families with financial hardships and the purchase of on-ice safety equipment for first time users.

The multi-page tournament program will consist of 36 black and white pages with a coloured cover, and 700 copies are required. Their request for support falls within the guidelines of Executive Committee Grants as a contribution toward overhead costs for a non-profit community group.

If the Committee wishes to support the request as recommended, a grant in the amount of up to \$3,000 to offset the estimated cost of printing the tournament program is required.
