REPORT

The Traffic Safety Committee, at its meeting held on 2011 November 01, received and adopted the *attached* report to respond to a request for lighting in the rear lane by Sandy Cen of 3934 Pandora Street.

A letter and petition was submitted by Sandy Cen signed by herself and her neighbours requesting the installation of lighting in the lane adjacent to their residences. Staff viewed the laneway and found that adequate poles are available for light installation. It is recommended that the installation of 1 (one) light in this lane be endorsed.

PURPOSE: To respond to a request for lighting in the rear lane by Sandy Cen of 3934 Pandora St.

RECOMMENDATION:


1. **THAT** the Committee endorse the installation of 1 (one) street light in the lane behind 3934 Pandora St.

REPORT

Sandy Cen has submitted a letter and petition signed by herself and her neighbours requesting the installation of lighting in the lane adjacent their residences. A petition with signatures of 2/3 of the affected properties must be submitted to the Engineering Department before the request can be forwarded to the Committee for endorsement and subsequently to BC Hydro. This requirement has been met.

Staff have viewed the laneway and have found that adequate poles are available for light installation. Further, we recommend that 1 (one) light be installed midpoint, as shown on the *attached* plan, which would be in keeping with spacing applied in other instances where lighting has been installed in lanes of similar length.

We recommend that the Committee endorse the installation of 1 (one) light in this lane. Staff will then forward a request to BC Hydro for installation and inform the applicant.
