An application request for \$3,000 has been received to support the “Mas” community workshop and July’vert event throughout the spring. The Carnival Sensations Caribbean Society’s mission is to work towards the evolution of Carnival in the Greater Vancouver area. They work throughout the year to create unique designs and costume concepts at their “mas” camp or workspace in Burnaby. They are seeking funds to support a series of open community workshops where participants can learn the various techniques of carnival costume making and design; and a small celebration “July’vert” on Canada Day.

The application has been completed in full and the applicant has demonstrated in the proposal that they can complete the project. The city’s grant would be used to cover eligible expenses related to the workshops including supplies and marketing, and support for the Canada Day party all of which are eligible expenses.
