An application request for \$2,275 has been received to support the Community Bike Fair on 2011 June 17. This is the 3rd annual Community Bike Fair, a free event for the whole family. The event promotes biking and fun, participants can participate in a challenge race, ride an obstacle course, decorate their bike, listen to live music and learn about the local trail systems.

The application has been completed in full and the applicant has demonstrated in the proposal that they can complete the project. The city's grant would be used to cover three specific items as identified in the grant, the performances of the Trail Stars, St. John's ambulance support and the decorations for the Decorate your Bike station, which are all eligible expenses but which are a lesser amount than the applicant's request.

It is recommended that the Executive Committee and Council award a Festivals Burnaby grant in the amount of \$2,200 to the Eastside Opportunities Society for the Community Bike Fair, 2011 June 17.
