An application request for \$990 has been received to support the Burnaby Youth Hub Barbeque and Celebration on 2011 June 17. The Burnaby Youth Hub is a one stop shop of support and services for youth in Burnaby. Core services include high school finishing programs, a clinic, a recreational drop-in centre and other programs offered through a series of agencies and other organizations. This new centre opened in September 2010 and this June signifies the end of the first program year of activities. To mark this event, the Lower Mainland Purpose Society would like to host an open house and celebration.

The application has been completed in full and the applicant has demonstrated in the proposal that they can complete the project. The city's grant would be used to support the creative component of the program which is an eligible expense.
