ROAD CLOSURES FOR SPECIAL EVENTS IN DEER LAKE PARK

PURPOSE:

To seek Council approval for temporary road closures.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. THAT Council approve the road closures as discussed in this report.

2. THAT the coordinator of the event, Cory Philley, Facility & Events Services Coordinator of Shadbolt Centre For the Arts, 6450 Deer Lake Ave, Burnaby, BC, V5G 2J3, be sent a copy of this report.

REPORT

A request to close City streets to alleviate potential traffic congestion during special events in Deer Lake Park has been received from Cory Philley, Facility & Events Services Coordinator from Shadbolt Centre for the Arts. Council approval is required by the Street & Traffic Bylaw.

The Shadbolt Centre for the Arts has submitted their 2012 schedule of Burnaby Festivals in Deer Lake Park. The following is a list of the special events and dates for the requested road closures:

- Foster the People Monday, June 25, 5:30 pm – 10:00 pm
- 2. 24th Annual Vancouver Symphony Orchestra Symphony in the Park (free) Sunday, July 15, 7:30 pm 9:30 pm
- 3. Florence & the Machine Friday, July 20, 5:30 pm 10:00 pm
- 4. Concert to be announced Monday, August 06, time to be announced
- 5. 13th Annual Burnaby Blues & Roosts Festival Saturday, August 11, 2:00 pm 10:00 pm
- 6. Concert to be announced Friday, August 31, time to be announced

Nearby residents and businesses in the Deer Lake Park area will be receiving written notification about these upcoming events.

In order to alleviate potential traffic congestion, Deer Lake Ave at Deer Lake Pkwy will be closed in the eastbound direction for 2 hours prior to the start of the festival and Deer Lake Ave between Deer Lake Pkwy and Sperling Ave will be fully closed for approximately 20-30 minutes after the festival ends (see *attached* map). City staff, RCMP and Coast Mountain Bus Company will be coordinating their efforts to ensure that the needs of residents, businesses, organizers and patrons are safely accommodated.

As this is a City event, liability insurance is not required.

The organizers are aware that approval is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That the road closure be conducted under the supervision of one person as organizer.
- 2. That all participants be instructed to respect the rights and property of the individuals encountered en route.
- 3. That the RCMP has agreed to monitor all barricades for the duration of the road closure.

4. That all emergency and transit services are advised of the event.


