PURPOSE:	To obtain approval to award a contract for the Al Street.	ternate Stre	eet Design – Watling

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

1. **THAT** a contract be awarded to the lowest bidder, Imperial Paving Ltd. for the Alternate Street Design – Watling Street for a total cost of \$366,613.91 including HST in the amount of \$39,280.06. Final payment will be based on actual quantities and unit prices tendered.

## REPORT

Nine tenders for this contract ranging from \$366,613.91 to \$585,817.12 were received by the closing time of 3:00 p.m., Thursday, 2012 May 31.

The work of this contract involves the removal of existing road structure to a depth of 0.9m and replacement with porous asphalt road construction, complete with new street lighting, 300m of storm sewer, 130m watermain and landscaping.

The recommended bidder, Imperial Paving Ltd. has completed several contracts for the City in the past and all were completed to the satisfaction of the City. Our consultant's review indicates the contractor has the equipment and personnel to successfully complete the work required under this contract. The Director Engineering concurs with this recommendation.

Appearing elsewhere on the Council agenda is an internal order report seeking funding approval for this project. These expenditures are included in the Roads and Water Utility components (EMD.0008 and EJA.0009) of the 2012 Annual Financial Plan.
