SUBJECT: 1ST ANNUAL DEER LAKE FUN RUN & WALK

PURPOSE: To seek Council approval for road closures related to the 1st Annual Deer Lake 5K Fun Run & Walk.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. **THAT** Council approve the road closures as outlined in this report.
2. **THAT** the coordinator of the event, Lucas Bjerke, Recreation Leader II, Edmonds Community Centre, 7252 Kingsway, Burnaby, BC V5E 1G3, be sent a copy of this report.

REPORT

A request to use City streets for the 1st Annual “Deer Lake 5K Fun Run & Walk” has been received from Lucas Bjerke, Recreation Leader II of the Edmonds Community Centre. Council approval for road closures is required by the Street & Traffic Bylaw.

Event organizers are proposing to use a combination of park trails and city streets on Saturday, 2012 May 26 (see *Figure 1*). They have requested the closure of the 6600 block Deer Lake Dr, Sperling between Deer Lake Dr and the northern driveway of the Deer Lake parking lot, the 6100 block Price St, and a traffic lane on Deer Lake Ave between Dale Ave and 6588 Deer Lake Ave between 8:00am and 10:30am (see *Figure 2*). The run starts at 8:30am and finishes at 10:30am followed by a barbecue at the parking lot at Deer Lake Park on Sperling. The organizers are expecting approximately 250 participants for the first year with approximately 150 spectators.

The organizers will be providing a letter two weeks in advance of the road closures to all affected residents and will be working closely with the community prior to the event to minimize any potential problems. The organizers are aware that approval is subject to the following conditions:

1. That the road closures be conducted under the supervision of one person as organizer.

2. That all participants be instructed to respect the rights and property of individuals encountered en route.
3. That the organizers are responsible for arranging for barricade volunteers for all barricade locations and traffic control personnel for the lane closure.

As this is a City event, liability insurance is not required.

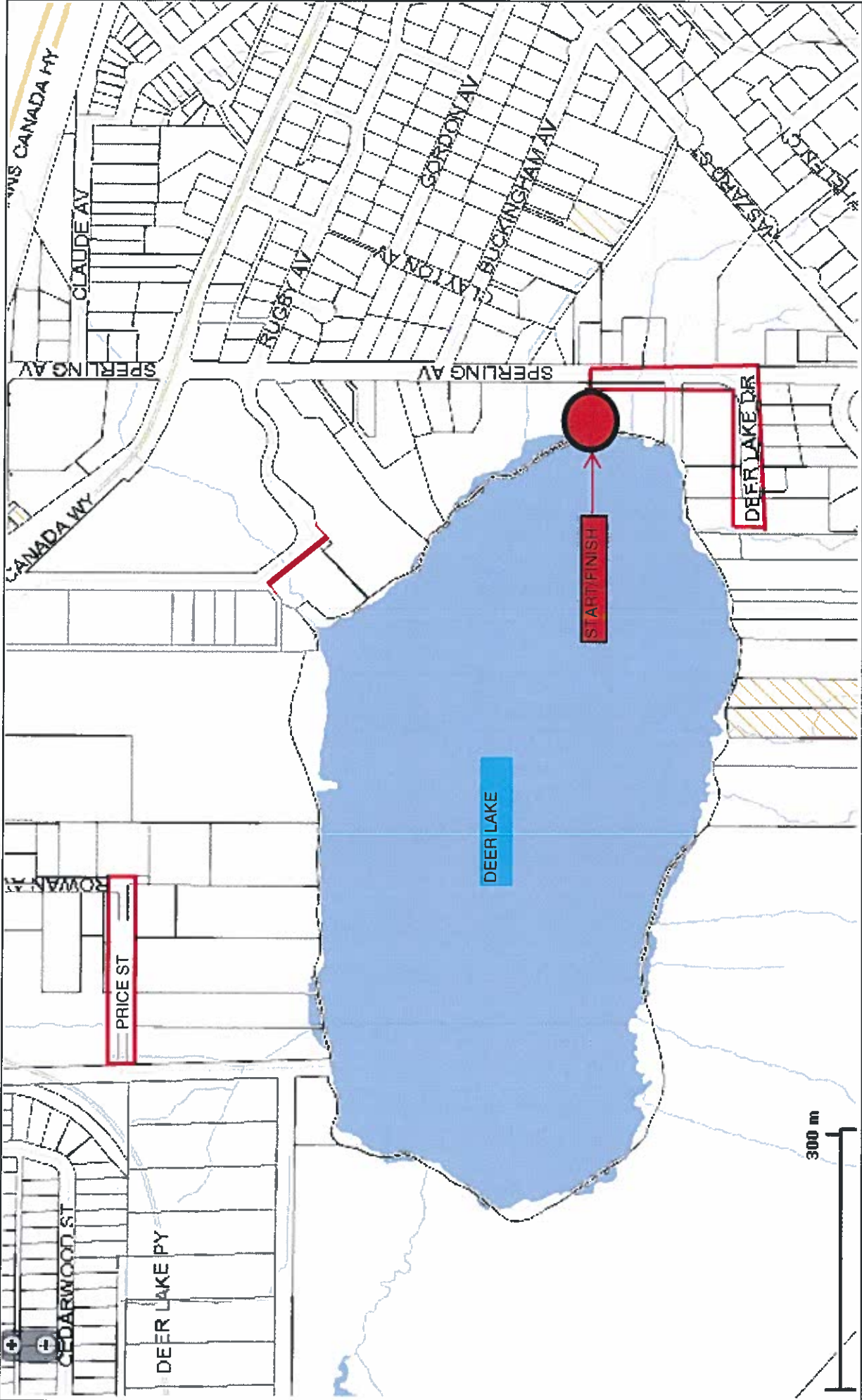

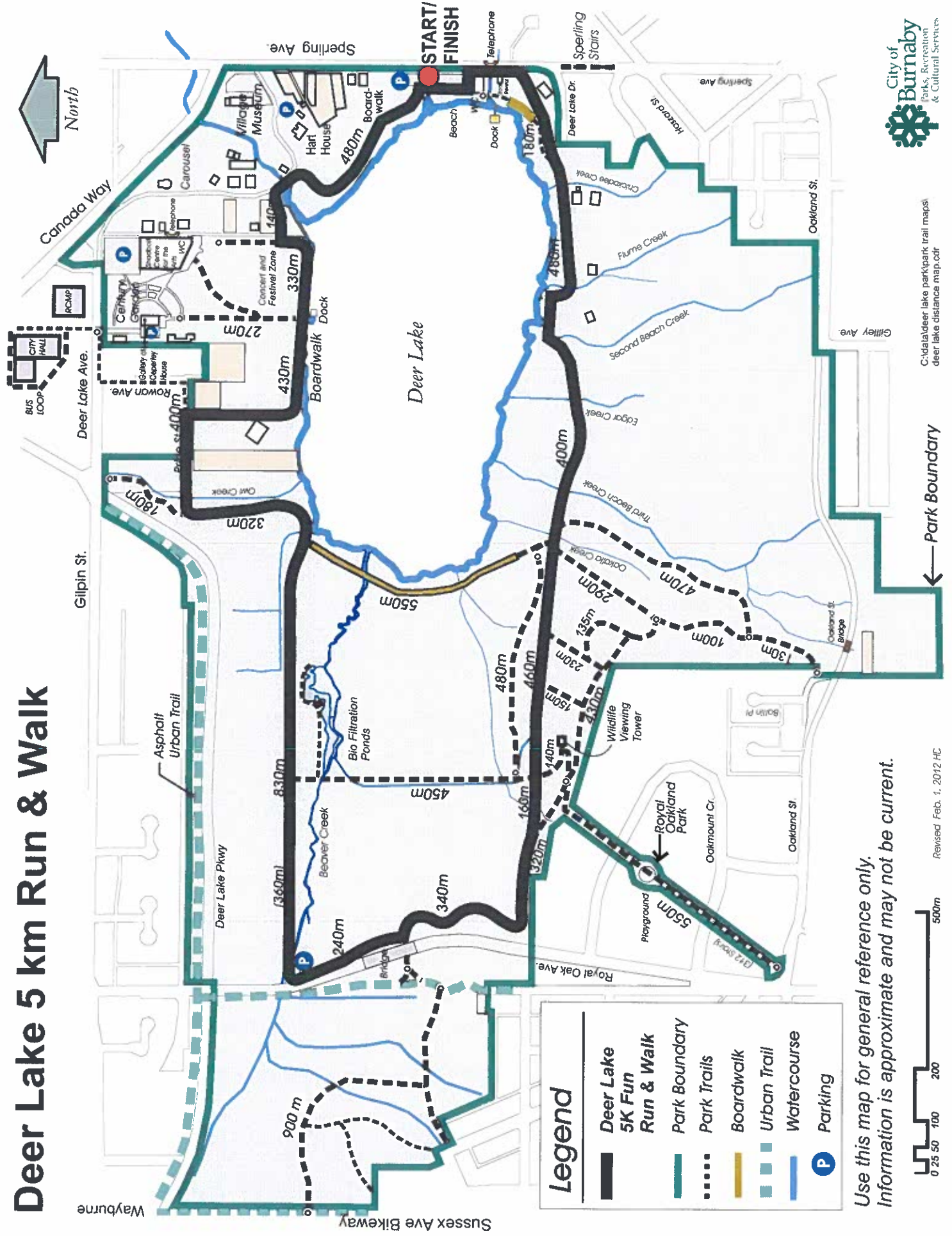
