**PURPOSE:** To seek Council approval for a temporary lane closure to facilitate a community event.

**RECOMMENDATIONS:**

1. **THAT** Council approve the temporary lane closure as discussed in this report.
2. **THAT** the coordinator of the event, Christy Beattie, Recreation Programmer, Eastburn Community Centre, 7252 Kingsway, Burnaby BC, V5E 1G3, be sent a copy of this report.

**REPORT**

A request to use a City lane way for a Canada Day Celebration on Sunday, 2012 July 01 has been received from Christy Beattie, Recreation Programmer, Eastburn Community Centre. Council approval is required by the Street & Traffic Bylaw.

The Canada Day celebration is normally held in Richmond Park directly across from Eastburn Community Centre. Last year the Eastburn Community Centre and Richmond Park were unavailable due to redevelopment and the location was changed to Ron McLean Park. This year, the celebration will again be held at Ron McLean Park. The event requires the closure of the lane way east of the 7600-7700 block of Hedley Ave (see *attached* map) between 8:00am and 4:00pm to facilitate setup and take down.

Approximately 2,500 people are expected to attend the multi-cultural entertainment between 11:00am and 2:30pm along with family activities such as badminton, soccer, art, water games and free birthday cake to celebrate Canada Day.


The organizers are aware that approval is subject to the following conditions:

1. That the lane closure be conducted under the supervision of one person as marshall or organizer.
2. That all participants be instructed to respect the rights and property of the individuals encountered en route.
