REPORT

Appearing elsewhere on Council's 2012 January 30 Open Council agenda is correspondence from the Metro Vancouver Board requesting the submission of nominations from the City for appointments to the Metro Vancouver Agricultural Advisory Committee. The current member nominated by Council to the Advisory Committee is Mr. Derek May. Mr. May has considerable hands-on farming experience in the region. Cranberry farming has been a part of his family history for almost 50 years, making Derek May a 6th generation farmer. The May family has over 300 acres of land in agricultural production in the region. Mr. May works alongside family members on Mayberry Farms in Richmond and Burnaby and plans to be actively involved in the continued successful management of the Mayberry Farms in Burnaby for years to come. In terms of the Advisory Committee's mandate, Mr. May has expressed a continuing interest in participating in the work of the Committee to support the enhancement of the agricultural community in the Lower Mainland.

As such, in considering Mr. May's expressed interest in being nominated for a further term on the Advisory Committee, his past service, and ongoing involvement in farming in Burnaby, I am recommending that Council forward his name to the Metro Vancouver Board for consideration for re-appointment to the Metro Vancouver Agricultural Advisory Committee.
