**PURPOSE:** To provide a status update on the construction progress for the Emergency

Generator and Electrical Room.

#### **REPORT**

#### 1.0 CONSTRUCTION SUMMARY

During the month of 2012 May, the contractor completed the concrete structure, damproofing, drainage mat and the majority of backfilling around the perimeter of the generator enclosure. Also completed was the installation of all underground conduits, in-ground pull boxes and the exterior transformer pad.

By mid-June, the contractor had completed the roof membrane over the electrical room, installed the exterior doors and air louver. The electrical room is now sufficiently weather-tight and secured to permit the installation of the new electrical equipment. One main electrical panel has been installed and the two automatic transfer switches are on site. The light fixtures and some branch wiring within the room is also underway at this time. The balance of electrical equipment will be arriving on site over the next few weeks.

When all electrical components are in place and wiring has been completed by the end of July, the contractor will initiate the selective demolition of the existing electrical equipment and switch over to the new system. A detailed schedule will be prepared and work will be scheduled for evenings and weekend to minimize the impact on the daily operation of City Hall and other City facilities.

The project is on budget and proceeding in an organized manner. The contractor's current project schedule indicates that construction will be substantially complete by the end of 2012 August. Staff will continue to monitor the progress and provide updated reports during the course of construction.
