SUBJECT: ASPHALTIC CONCRETE PAVEMENT REPAIRS

PURPOSE: To obtain approval to extend the contract for pavement repairs for the period of 2012 August 15 to 2013 August 14.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council approve a one year extension to the contract with Winvan Paving Ltd., for asphaltic concrete pavement repairs. The estimated cost total is \$308,548.80 including HST of \$33,058.80. The final payment will be based on actual quantities ordered and current unit prices.

REPORT

In 2011 August, the City went to the marketplace for asphaltic concrete pavement repairs for the period 2011 September 1 to 2012 August 14. The tender resulted in the award of a contract to Winvan Paving Ltd. The tender document allowed for up to four (4) one year extensions. It is recommended that the contract be extended for the period of 2012 August 15 to 2013 August 14.

This contract extension is being recommended based on pricing received and evaluated against current unit prices and market conditions. Winvan Paving Ltd. has agreed to hold all current prices firm for the contract period. The work of this contract includes cold milling and pavement repairs following utility construction work and/or to repair isolated sections of deteriorated pavement on various roadways throughout the City of Burnaby. Winvan Paving Ltd. has a proven track record in the supply of these services.

Funding for this contract is as follows: \$100,000 is provided from the 2012 Engineering Roads & Drainage Operating Budget; \$75,000 is provided in the 2012 Watermain – (EJA.0009) capital project and 2013 Watermain capital project. The balance of \$133,548.80 will be included in the 2013 portion of the Engineering Roads & Drainage Operating Budget.
