SUBJECT: 2ND ANNUAL DEER LAKE FUN RUN & WALK

PURPOSE: To seek Council approval for road closures related to the 2nd Annual Deer lake 5K Fun Run & Walk

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. **THAT** Council approve the road closure as discussed in this report.
2. **THAT** the coordinator of the event, Don Doyle, Recreation Leader II, Bonsor Recreation Complex, 6550 Bonsor Ave, Burnaby, BC V5H 3G4, be sent a copy of this report.

REPORT

A request from the Bonsor Recreation Complex to use City streets for their 2nd Annual "Deer Lake 5K Fun Run & Walk" has been received from Don Doyle, Recreation Leader II. Council approval is required by the Street & Traffic Bylaw.

Event organizers are proposing to use a combination of park trails and City streets on Saturday, 2013 May 25 (see *Figure 1*). They have requested the closure of several streets (see *Figure 2*) and these are listed below along with their closure times.

- 6600 block Deer Lake Dr (8:00am to 9:00am)
- Sperling Ave between Deer Lake Dr and Deer Lake Ave (8:00am to 9:00am)
- Deer Lake Ave between Sperling Ave and Century Park Dr (8:00am and 9:00am)
- 6100 block Price St (8:30am to 10:00am)


The run starts at 8:30am and finishes at 10:30am followed by a barbecue at the parking lot at Deer Lake Park on Sperling Ave. The organizers are expecting approximately 300 participants for the second year with approximately 150 spectators.

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The organizers will be providing a letter two weeks in advance of the road closures to all affected residents and will be working closely with the community prior to the event to minimize any potential problems. The organizers are aware that approval is subject to the following conditions:

1. That the road closures be conducted under the supervision of one person as organizer.
2. That all participants be instructed to respect the rights and property of individuals encountered en route.
3. That the organizers are responsible for arranging for barricade volunteers for all barricade locations and traffic control personnel for the road closures.

As this is a City event, liability insurance is not required.
