REPORT

A request to close City streets to alleviate potential traffic congestion during special events in Deer Lake Park has been received from Cory Philley, Facility & Events Services Coordinator from Shadbolt Centre for the Arts. Council approval is required by the Street & Traffic Bylaw.

The Shadbolt Centre for the Arts has submitted their 2013 schedule of Burnaby Festivals in Deer Lake Park. The following is a list of the special events and dates for the requested road closures:

1. Sigur Ros
Monday, May 27 7pm to 10pm
2. Fox Fest
Monday, July 01 6pm to 10pm
3. 25th Annual Vancouver Symphony Orchestra – Symphony in the Park
Sunday, July 14 7:30pm to 10:00pm
4. 14th Annual Burnaby Blues & Roots Festival
Saturday, August 10 2pm to 10pm

Nearby residents and businesses in the Deer Lake Park area will be receiving written notification about these upcoming events.

In order to alleviate potential traffic congestion, Deer Lake Ave at Deer Lake Pkwy will be closed in the eastbound direction for 2 hours prior to the start of each event and Deer Lake Ave between Deer Lake Pkwy and Sperling Ave will be fully closed for approximately 20-30 minutes after the end of each event (see *attached* map). City staff, RCMP and Coast Mountain Bus Company will be coordinating their efforts to ensure that the needs of residents, businesses, organizers and patrons are safely accommodated.

As these are City events, liability insurance is not required.

The organizers are aware that approval is subject to the following conditions:

1. That the road closure be conducted under the supervision of one person as organizer.
2. That all participants be instructed to respect the rights and property of the individuals encountered en route.
3. That the RCMP has agreed to monitor all barricades for the duration of the road closure.
4. That all emergency and transit services are advised of the event.

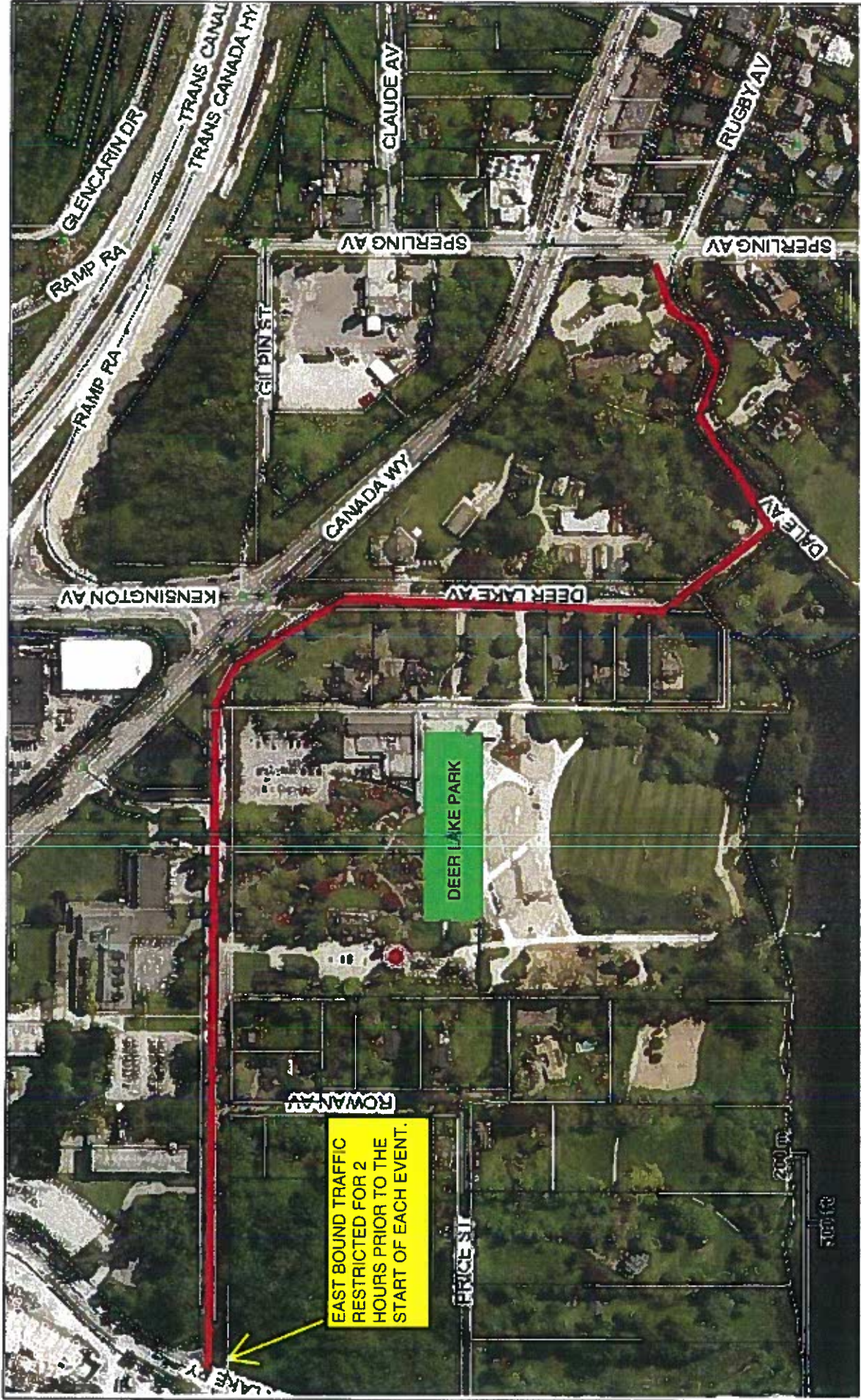
