**PURPOSE:** To request funding to update and reprint the Deer Lake Park Heritage Walking Tour brochure.

## **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

- 2. THAT a copy of this report be forwarded to the Parks, Recreation and Culture Commission for their information.

#### REPORT

Since 2001, the Community Heritage Commission has produced a walking tour guide for Deer Lake Park to highlight its history and heritage as part of the City's tourism strategy. The Deer Lake Park Heritage Walking Tour is highlighted as an activity for both residents and visitors in the Burnaby Visitor's Guide and on the City's website.

The Deer Lake Park Heritage Walking Tour brochure is proposed to be updated and redesigned. The new brochure would be expanded to include the completed Lake Loop Trail around Deer Lake. This new route provides walkers with the opportunity to view the 1912 Craftsman-style R.M. Edgar House and to obtain historical information on the Oakalla lands. A copy of the updated brochure will be provided to the Commission and Council under separate cover, once complete.

As in previous years, the walking tour brochure will be distributed, free of charge, to Burnaby residents and visitors through the following civic owned facilities:

- Burnaby Public Libraries
- City of Burnaby Community and Recreation Centres
- City Hall
- Tourist Info Kiosk at Metropolis, Metrotown

- Shadbolt Centre for the Arts
- Gallery at Ceperley House
- Burnaby Village Museum
- Hart House

The brochure would also be distributed during special events in Deer Lake Park such as Symphony in the Park (2014 July 13) and Burnaby Blues and Roots Festival (2014 August 09) and posted on the City website.

The requested \$2,000.00 expenditure would provide for the printing of 3,000 copies of the new brochure at the City of Burnaby's Print Shop. The City Clerk has advised that sufficient funds for this project are available in the Commission's 2014 annual operating budget.
