RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. **THAT** Council receive the City Clerk's Certificate of Sufficiency covering the City Initiated 2015 Local Area Service Interim Walks Program.
2. **THAT** on receipt of the successful petition, the City Solicitor prepare a Local Area Service Construction Bylaw for the successful project.
3. **THAT** on receipt of the successful petition, the City Solicitor prepare a Local Area Service Fund Expenditure Bylaw for the successful project.
4. **THAT** the owners of the properties on the petitions be advised of the outcome.

REPORT

With respect to Council initiated local area services, Section 213(2)(c) of the Community Charter states:

“Council may proceed with establishing the service unless a petition against the service is presented within 30 days after notice has been given in accordance with this Section.”

Petitions have been received in objection to 15-400 local area service project, detailed in the *attached* schedule. Council is precluded from proceeding with this project as the petitions represent at least 50% of the property owners who, in turn represent at least 50% of the assessed value of land and improvements that would be subject to the local area service tax.

Insufficient petitions have been received in objection to 15-402 local area service project, detailed in the *attached* schedule. Council may proceed with the work as provided for in Section 213(2)(c) of the Community Charter.
