2014 CAPITAL PROJECT

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. THAT the expenditure of \$150,000 from the 2014-2018 Financial Plan for the project outlined in this report be approved.
- 2. THAT Council be requested to bring down a bylaw to appropriate \$157,010 (inclusive of GST) from Capital Reserves to finance this project.

REPORT

The 2014-2018 Financial Plan for Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services contains the following project to be funded from Capital Reserves. To enable work to go ahead on this project, approval is requested to bring down a bylaw for funding.

1. Mathers House Facility Renovation and Upgrade: Phase 1

\$150,000

To redesign and upgrade the main floor common areas, washrooms, studio and storage spaces for the ceramics program, and to improve facility access and heritage features in a phased project.

Sufficient Capital Reserves are available to complete the above project in the 2014-2018 Financial Plan. It is recommended that Council be requested to bring down a bylaw to appropriate \$157,010 (inclusive of GST) from Capital Reserves to finance this project.
