**PURPOSE:** 

To seek Council approval for the issuance of a Heritage Alteration Permit for this

Designated Heritage Site.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

1. THAT the Community Heritage Commission recommend Council approve the issuance of a Heritage Alteration Permit for the R.F. Anderson House located at 6450 Deer Lake Avenue, as outlined in this report.

#### REPORT

#### 1.0 BACKGROUND

The R.F. Anderson House is a City-owned heritage building which was designated in 1992. It is currently being used as an office for the Shadbolt Centre for the Arts. As part of the City's overall maintenance program for this structure, exterior repainting and a number of minor exterior repairs will be completed this year. The subject proposal includes the repair of a small balcony on the upper floor (see *Attachment 1*). This minor project requires approval of a Heritage Alteration Permit. This report outlines the proposed works for the consideration of the Community Heritage Commission and Council.

### 2.0 HERITAGE ALTERATION PERMIT

Under the *Local Government Act*, all structures protected by Heritage Designation Bylaws require that a Heritage Alteration Permit be issued by Council to legally allow for any proposed material and design alterations and building relocations. Burnaby's Community Heritage Commission reviews all applications for Heritage Alteration Permits for recommendation to Council for consideration following the review of the proposed alterations.

#### 3.0 BALCONY RESTORATION

The original design for the R.F. Anderson House included an upper storey balcony which is proposed to be repaired and a new railing installed based on its original design (see *Attachment* 2). The drawings were prepared based on historic photos of the R.F. Anderson House. The restoration of this feature will allow for repainting of the building to proceed as scheduled prior to fall of this year. The new balcony railing would restore this building element and also enhance the overall heritage appearance of the building, which is prominently located facing the Shadbolt Centre's eastern public plaza. Funding for this project is available within existing building maintenance budgets, and the works will be completed by City crews.

The proposed changes have been designed to ensure a high-degree of quality and craftsmanship to ensure its integration as part of the building's exterior design. As the proposal respects the heritage values and character of the R.F. Anderson House and restores an integral part of its exterior design, it is recommended that the Community Heritage Commission and Council approve this Heritage Alteration Permit.

#### 4.0 NEXT STEPS

With Council adoption of the recommendation of this report, City staff will process the building permit application and complete the proposed restoration of the balcony in compliance with the approved Heritage Alteration Permit.




