RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT a *Festivals Burnaby – Neighbourhood* grant in the amount of \$3,000 be awarded to the Chinese Taoism Kuan Kung Association of Canada in support of the Tian Jin Festival on 2014 April 26 and 27 in Burnaby.

REPORT

An application was received from the Chinese Taoism Kuan Kung Association of Canada to support the Tian Jin Festival in Burnaby on 2014 April 26 and 27. The festival promotes and shares Chinese culture and enhances local cultural exchange through stage performance, traditional crafts and family activities. Festivals Burnaby funds would be allocated towards eligible project expenses related to programming, marketing/promotions and administration.
