SUBJECT: **COST SHARING AGREEMENT – METRO VANCOUVER, BURNABY LAKE NORTH INTERCEPTOR #2**

PURPOSE: To seek Council approval to enter into a cost sharing agreement with Metro Vancouver for watermain upgrades on Lougheed Hwy in conjunction with a Metro Vancouver project.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. **THAT** Council approve the expenditure of \$125,000 (inclusive of 5% GST) for watermain upgrades on Lougheed Hwy, east of Kingsland Drive, in association with the above referenced project.
2. **THAT** the City Solicitor be authorized to prepare a cost sharing agreement with Metro Vancouver (GVS&DD) in the amount not to exceed \$125,000 (inclusive of 5% GST) for watermain upgrades on Lougheed Hwy, east of Kingsland Drive.

REPORT

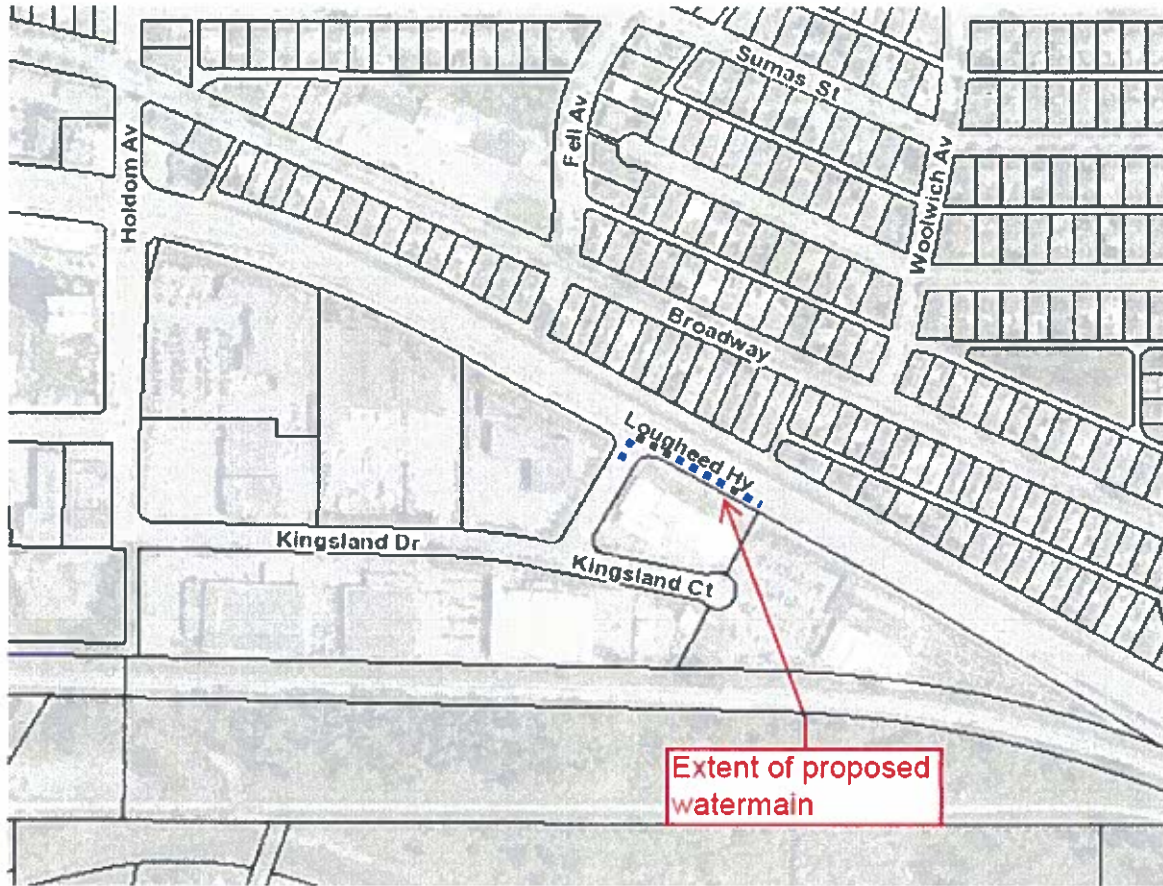
Metro Vancouver’s (MV) 10-year Capital Plan includes provision for twinning of their existing Burnaby Lake North Interceptor (BLNI) to accommodate growth and re-development within the Brentwood and Holdom Town Centre Areas of north Burnaby. MV is scheduled to tender their project shortly, with construction beginning by May 2014.

As an integrated approach to overall infrastructure renewal and cost effectiveness, staff has negotiated a cost sharing arrangement with MV to upgrade existing water servicing within the immediate area of Lougheed Hwy, east of Kingsland Drive. Total cost for this work, including engineering and construction, is estimated at \$125,000 (inclusive of 5% GST). These expenditures are included in the current Financial Plan.

Construction of the total project involves twinning of an existing MV owned sanitary trunk line and upgrades to City infrastructure and may have an impact on area residents and businesses. Staff will work with MV and their contractor in consultation with area residents to develop an appropriate construction plan that will minimize impacts and potential disruption.
