Replacement of the 1993 playground structure to meet life cycle replacement timeline. Accessibility improvements will be included in the work. Completion planned for the Fall of 2015. 3. Recreation Equipment

- 4. **Safety and Security** **\$40,000**
Replacement and upgrades of security equipment (cameras, recorders, lighting, etc.) at selected recreation centres for public and staff safety.
