## REPORT

The 2016 Provisional Financial Plan for Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services contains the following nine projects to be funded from Capital Reserves. To enable work to go ahead on these projects, approval is requested to bring down a bylaw for funding

| 2. | <b>Parks Minor Development</b> (DPW.0259)<br>Minor capital replacement work at various park locations due to breakdowns, vandalism, or unanticipated capital repairs. Projects done in the past include irrigation systems and turf replacement. | <b>\$150,000</b> |
| 3. | <b>Burnaby Mountain Golf Course</b> (DPW.0251)<br>Tee area redevelopment and construction to improve a number of tee surfaces and first phase of development of forward tees on select holes.  | <b>\$30,000</b>  |
