RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT a *Festivals Burnaby* grant – *Neighbourhood Event* in the amount of \$2,500 be awarded to Scandinavian Cultural Society for the Leif Erikson Day Festival to be held on 2016 October 15-16.

REPORT

An application was received from the Scandinavian Cultural Society requesting a grant to support the Leif Erikson Day Festival to be held on 2016 October 15-16 at the Scandinavian Community Centre. This festival celebrates Leif Erikson Day and annually features the history, current endeavours and contributions that one particular Nordic Country has made to Canada by its emigrants. Sweden is the featured country for 2016. Activities include talks and presentations by experts, music and folkdance, craft workshops, displays and exhibitions, film, children's programming and cultural foods.

The Lyrids Folk Dance festival is intended to be a multi-faceted experience to share cultures from the Balkans and its
