SUBJECT: WATER BOTTLING OF GROUNDWATER

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council write a letter to the Minister of Environment and Climate Change, Honourable George Heyman, calling for a moratorium on new water bottling licences

REPORT

1.0 INTRODUCTION

At the Environment Committee held on 2021 September 14, correspondence was received from Mr. Bruce Gibbons asking that the City of Burnaby add their voices to the call for the provincial government to enact the 2019 Union of British Columbia Municipalities (UBCM) resolution and take action by calling for a moratorium on new water bottling licenses.

In 2019, the UBCM members passed a resolution asking the provincial government to stop approving licences for the bottling and commercial sale and bulk export of groundwater. To date, the provincial government has not taken action on the request and continues to entertain applications for water bottling of British Columbia's groundwater.

2.0 POLICY

The City advocating to protect and conserve water supports a number of the goals within the City's Climate Action Plan. It also supports the City's Corporate Strategic Plan, as follows:
