(8950 Centaurus Circle -- Located in an area lying between Gaglardi Way and the Northwest corner of Centaurus Circle)

Mr. L. Whaley, #201 - 6822 Arcola Street, Burnaby 1, B. C. spoke and stated that he felt the changes in the plan would produce an excellent development and urged Council to approve the scheme.

Mr. Michael Audain, Special Advisor to the Provincial Minister of Housing, then addressed the meeting and stated that the scheme was sponsored by the Provincial Government.

Mr. B. Hecker, Architect for the project, then displayed a number of models, slides and sketches of the development proposal, and outlined the changes desired in the scheme. He stressed that the developer was endeavouring to achieve a way of developing units so that each could have his own identity. In that regard, he outlined the visual and functional aspects of the development, pointing out that it would have three orientations.

Mr. Hecker also indicated that there was a slight reduction in the number of units and that it was proposed to build more dens and alter some of the dimensions of the units.

Mr. Hecker concluded by stating that a co-operative society would own the development.

In response to questions, Mr. Hecker stated that there was no alternate plan and that the cost of the project would be between \$25.00 and \$30.00 per square foot.

Mr. R. Naude, 6767 Kitchener Street, spoke and lauded the development scheme by urging that Council support the proposal.
