The purpose of the proposed rezoning bylaw amendment is to permit the establishment of a retail beer and wine store.

A petition dated 1989 January was received containing the signatures of one hundred seventy three (173) residents/employees/employers of the area <u>IN SUPPORT</u> of the rezoning application. The text of the petition is contained hereunder:

"We, the undersigned, reside and/or are employed within an approximate one half mile radius of the Marine Pub and support the proposed application for a cold beer and wine store at 5820 S.E. Marine Drive, Burnaby, B.C. (adjacent to the Pub)."

In addition, letters were received from one hundred seven (107) residents/employees/employers of the area expressing their support for the rezoning application.

Colin W. Craig, Architect, 190 Highview Place, Lions Bay, addressed the members of Council and with the assistance of an artist's rendering provided a synopsis of the proposed development for the members of Council and the general public.

Corrine Aelbers, 6007 Byrne Road, addressed the members of Council and advised that she has been a resident in the area for seven (7) years and expressed her support for the rezoning application which, in her opinion, would be an asset to the community.

Gary Haverty of Hank's Sportswear, 5741 Byrne Road, addressed the members of Council in support of the rezoning application.

William Shurvell, #208-5217 Clinton Street, addressed the members of Council in support of the rezoning application.

Raymond V. Poitras, President, Vic's Battery Service, 5741 Byrne Road, addressed the members of Council in support of the rezoning application.
